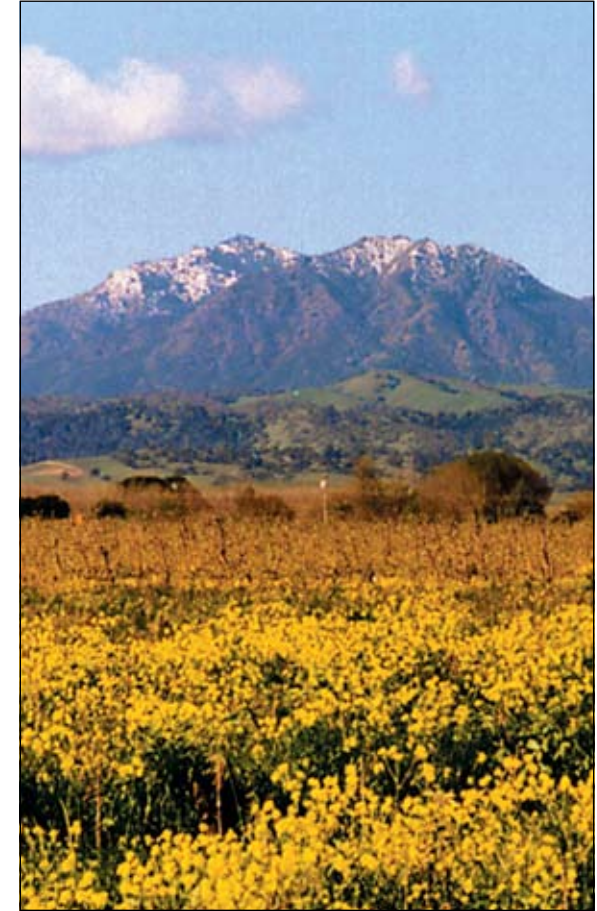

## RECYCLING SERVICE

Commercial recycling customers have several options. Depending on space availability, volume of material or collection location, bins or carts can be used.

For a free waste assessment of your current solid waste and recycling programs, please call us at (925) 671-5806.

Recycling carts should be in the same location as your refuse carts or dumpsters. Except for cardboard, separating recycling materials is not necessary: newspapers, paper



**Residents can store their recycling materials in any container, including paper bags, buckets or cartons, before placing them in cart.**

• Have residents store recyclables in their apartment or condo in a place that is convenient for them. They can use cloth or paper bags, buckets or other containers that can hold recyclables.

The recycling carts will be clearly marked and are suitable for all recyclables — paper, metal, glass and plastics. See accompanying list for the types of items that may be placed in the cart.

## HAZARDOUS WASTES

It is illegal (by state law) to place hazardous and electronic wastes in the garbage. None of these materials should ever be placed in dumpsters at apartment, condominium and other multi-family complexes.

Property owners of a complex are responsible for the removal of any hazardous or electronic waste in a dumpster, whether generated by the complex or not.



If the hazardous or electronic waste is not removed, Allied Waste Services will charge the complex a hazardous waste disposal fee. For information regarding what Allied Waste Services considers hazardous and electronic waste, call (925) 603-1383 or go to <http://awsccc.com>.

Residents of your complex may recycle hazardous wastes such as oil filters, used motor oil, antifreeze, latex paint, mercury thermometers, fluorescent bulbs and household and car batteries at local recycling facilities:

- ♻️ **Allied Waste Services Recycling Drop-Off Center**, 133 S. Buchanan Circle, Pacheco. Hours are 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday. Closed Saturday, Sunday, holidays. Phone: (925) 685-4711. Center serves residential customers of Allied Waste Services.
- ♻️ **Household Hazardous Waste Collection Center**, 4797 Imhoff Place, Martinez. Phone: (800) 646-1431 or go to [www.centalsan.org](http://www.centalsan.org) for information. The center serves residents of Contra Costa County.
- ♻️ **Delta Diablo Household Hazardous Waste Collection Facility**, 2550 Pittsburg-Antioch Highway, Antioch. Call (925) 756-1990 or go online at [www.ddsd.org](http://www.ddsd.org). The facility serves residents of Antioch, Bay Point, Brentwood, Oakley, Pittsburg and unincorporated areas of East Contra Costa County.
- ♻️ **Benicia Corporation Yard**, 2400 E. 2nd St., Benicia. Hours are 9 a.m.-noon Saturday for motor oil, oil filters, anti-freeze, fluorescent tubes and household and car batteries. Recyclables accepted 24 hours a day. The site serves Benicia residents.
- ♻️ **Devlin Road Transfer Station**, 899A Devlin Road, American Canyon. Call (800) 984-9661 for information and hours. The transfer station serves residents of Solano County.

## Appliances

California law prohibits putting refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners or any other appliance with Freon in the garbage. Also prohibited are mercury-containing appliances such as microwave ovens, clothes dryers, water heaters, furnaces and space heaters in the garbage.

Allied Waste Services will pick up hazardous appliances at your property for a fee. For information or to arrange a pickup, call (925) 603-1383.

## Computer Monitors, Television Sets

State law bans TVs and computer monitors (CRTs) from garbage. Allied Waste Services will pick up TVs, computer monitors and electronic waste items at your property for a fee.
